DAILY / WEEKLY INSPECTION			
SAT	UNS	N/A	Item
			Check loose fill to make sure that turnbuckles, clevises and anchor plates are covered.
			Check for any obvious signs of wear on steel cables at joints. (Nylon wear is not considered.)

In addition to the items above, we recommend the following checked monthly:

MONTHLY INSPECTION			
SAT	UNS	N/A	Item
			Uncover turnbuckles (if in loose fill) and ensure they are properly connected. Recover to proper depth.
			Visually inspect all connections for signs of wear/cracking.
			Check that posts are properly seated on anchor plates and do not permit more than 20° of movement in any direction.
			Check post caps to make sure they are correctly seated.

In addition to the items above, we recommend the following checked yearly:

YEARLY INSPECTION			
SAT	UNS	N/A	Item
			Check tension on exterior cables. Cables should allow 2-3" (50-75mm) of deflection to be considered tight. Adjust turnbuckles if necessary.

UNS: Unsatisfactory / Non-compliant

N/A: Not Applicable

NOTE: The items included on this checklist are over and above your standard playground inspection routine that would cover details such as checking for adequate surfacing underneath the products and removing broken glass or other debris from the playground. Playground inspections should be carried out on a regularly scheduled basis. Playgrounds with heavy use or in coastal areas may require more frequent inspection.
